ICCJ Code of Conduct

Principles for Personal Interaction

The International Council of Christians and Jews is committed to creating a safe, inclusive, and reverent environment where people of all faith traditions, spiritual practices, and non-religious perspectives can engage in meaningful dialogue to promote mutual understanding. It affirms the inherent dignity of every person and their right to “safe spaces” where they will not be disrespected in any way. The ICCJ is committed to this goal in all its programs and venues, including related events, unofficial social gatherings, and online meetings.

By its very nature, interreligious dialogue demands special sensitivity to others’ experiences, situations in life, and religious or non-religious traditions, practices, and worldviews. It seeks to comprehend, not to persuade or proselytize.

Participants in ICCJ events agree to be self-critical of their own assumptions and to graciously accept corrections of misunderstandings or errors about another tradition. They will respect others’ personal spaces, personal convictions, personal dignity, and personal histories.

Equally, there will be no tolerance for any form of verbal or physical sexual harassment, such as:

- Inappropriate speech including sexual references, innuendos or suggestive remarks;
- unwelcome sexual attention;
- unwelcome or inappropriate physical contact.

IN CASE OF AN INCIDENT

If while attending an ICCJ event, you have been involved in an incident that violates these principles, please report it to the ICCJ, represented by the General Secretary, Anette Adelman. Reports will be treated confidentially.

All incidents reported will be investigated with discretion, confidentiality, and impartiality.

Violation of these principles will result in sanctions.
